Thank you for taking the time to meet again on 20th April 2018 to discuss the development of the ADGEX GreenBLAZE and EnergyBRICK products and potential project in Queensland. Based on our discussions it appears that your technologies could assist the State Government meet some of its current policy objectives, including to drive renewable energy production and economic development in the state.

I understand that ADGEX is in discussions with financiers to assist with developing its proposed project to demonstrate the capabilities of these products. Projects of this type that meet our objectives are eligible for government facilitation support that includes: streamlining of approvals; access to government contacts to assist with negotiating and identifying resources; assistance with resource availability and site selection; access to economic data; and liaison across government agencies.

As well as supporting a renewable energy target of 50 per cent by 2030 the Government also supports a sustainable and renewable biofuels sector as part of its Biofutures commitment.
